

NCCC in a Nutshell

The Corvette Club of Arizona (CCA) is one of the 12 National Corvette Council Clubs (NCCC) in the Roadrunner Region which includes Arizona, New Mexico and El Paso, Texas.

NCCC was founded in the United States as an all volunteer, non-profit organization in 1959 by a small group of Corvette owners and enthusiasts. The purpose of NCCC is to promote interest in Corvette ownership and operation, to publish information on the use and operation of the Corvette and to establish an organized effort to encourage others to participate in the enjoyment connected with the use and ownership of the Corvette - America's Sports Car!

There are about 250 NCCC clubs in 16 Regions both East and West of the Mississippi, with more than 9,000 NCCC members.

NCCC encourages interaction between individual clubs with the Competition Program, Websites, and Newsletters. One of the major benefits of the Competition Program is the \$5 million liability insurance coverage.
